Welcome to Trinity Laban!

This booklet will give you some information about our Dance Ability classes for children.

This is The Laban Building, which is our home.



This is how you get to us from the street:





Our security guard Dennis will welcome you. Remember to wave hello to him!



Make sure you don't press the barriers!
Dennis will let you through on the left hand side.



Classes take place in Studio 1. This is how you get there from the barriers:

First go straight ahead, up this ramp:



Turn left by the first white bench, just past the Box Office. This is what you can see:



And head down the ramp. Studio 1 is on the left hand side:

Take a seat on or near the bench outside the Studio.

You can get changed now – you'll need to wear comfy track-suit bottoms or leggings with a t-shirt. You don't need any special shoes or socks to dance in – you'll dance barefoot!

You'll then say "see you later!" to your adult, who will wait near the Studio or in the café. You will be led into the Studio. Bring a water bottle with you.
